

Ordinance No. [2024-029]

An Ordinance Repealing Certain Dog Licensing Ordinances in the City of Tuckerman, Arkansas

WHEREAS, the City of Tuckerman recognizes that certain ordinances concerning dog licensing and control cannot be located and are considered lost in time and

WHEREAS, to ensure clarity and maintain effective regulation, it is necessary to repeal the following ordinances:

1. **Ordinance #39 (10-1917)** Requires a license for dogs over three months old, mandates that dogs wear a tag, and prohibits any vicious dogs (licensed or not) from running at large.
2. **Ordinance #41 (1918)** Requires a license for any dog over three months old, with an annual renewal; mandates a tag for the dog; permits the Marshal to euthanize unlicensed dogs.
3. **Ordinance #56 (10-1923)** Amends Ordinance #41 by increasing the age for licensing to six months and changing the renewal period from January to October.
4. **Ordinance #66 (2-1927)** States that dogs found running at large or loose must be confined, or the owner risks a fine of five to twenty-five dollars.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF TUCKERMAN, ARKANSAS:


Section 1: The aforementioned ordinances—Ordinance #39, Ordinance #41, Ordinance #56, and Ordinance #66—are hereby repealed in their entirety.

Section 2: This ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its passage and approval.

Section 3: All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with this ordinance are hereby repealed.
